Executive Proclamation by *Governor Michael J. Dunleavy*

Under the authority of Article II, Section 9, and Article III, Section 17, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and in the public interest, I call the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Alaska into its first special session in the legislative chambers in Juneau, Alaska, at 10:00 a.m., on May 16, 2019, to consider the following subjects:

- An Act making appropriations for public education and transportation of students.
- HB 39 or similar bill making appropriations for the operating and loan program expenses of state government and for certain programs; capitalizing funds; amending appropriations; making appropriations under art. IX, sec. 17(c), Constitution of the State of Alaska, from the constitutional budget reserve fund.
- HB 40 or similar bill making appropriations for the operating and capital expenses of the state's integrated comprehensive mental health program.
- SB 19 or similar bill making appropriations, including capital appropriations, supplemental appropriations, reappropriations, and other appropriations; amending appropriations; making appropriations to capitalize funds.
- HB 49 relating to criminal law and procedure.
