**RELATING TO THE SUSPENSION OF SECTIONS OF
ALASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AND SECTIONS OF ALASKA STATUTES**

I, Mike Dunleavy, Governor of the State of Alaska, do hereby authorize this amendment to Disaster Order of Suspension No. 2 (“Order”). Pursuant to the Order, the language of each provision set forth below is hereby suspended until **the expiration of the disaster declaration**, unless otherwise individually noted. The disaster declaration is set to expire on November 15, 2020, absent further action by the legislature. This amendment takes immediate effect upon signature unless otherwise individually noted.


