



Alaska's International Airports

- **ALASKA IS THE PRIMARY CARGO MIDPOINT FOR ASIA/US FREIGHTER TRAFFIC**
 - Majority of Asia/US freighter operations are via Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport – averaged 94 wide body air cargo landings each day in 2017
 - TSAIA creates one out of ten jobs in Anchorage
 - Fairbanks International Airport creates 1 in 20 jobs in Fairbanks, about 1900 jobs
- **INTERNATIONAL VISITOR DESTINATION FOR ASIA AND EUROPE**
 - Seasonal passenger service provided by Condor, Icelandair, Air Russia, Air North
 - Seasonal charter flights provided by Korean Air, China Airlines, Japan Airlines, Uzbekistan Airways and All Nippon Airways.
 - In 2017 approximately 786 passengers per week flew to Alaska from Asia via other airports
Alaska Travel Industry Association and local CVBs such as Visit Anchorage and Explore Fairbanks promote Alaska to international markets





Alaska Seafood Exports - \$2.43 billion in 2017




Alaska Mineral Ore Exports - \$1.80 billion in 2017





Alaska Forest Products Exports - \$72.0 million in 2017




Alaska Fish Meal Exports - \$99.2 million in 2017




Alaska Aircraft/Parts Exports - \$85.5 million in 2017



Alaska Machinery Exports - \$77.0 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to China - \$1.3 billion in 2017




Alaska Exports to Japan - \$812.4 million in 2017





Alaska Exports to Canada - \$706.6 million in 2017





Alaska Exports to South Korea - \$669.1 in 2017




Alaska Exports to Germany - \$181.7 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to the Netherlands - \$181.0 million in 2017



Alaska Exports to Spain - \$161.3 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Australia - \$158.6 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Malaysia - \$72.3 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to France - \$70.5 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Italy - \$67.7 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Belgium - \$60.7 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Thailand - \$60.4 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Finland - \$57.3 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Taiwan - \$50.6 million in 2017




Alaska Exports to Peru - \$37.4 million in 2017
